Records to be turned in for Judging in Kankakee County

Each 4-H'er needs to turn in a complete set of records, which consists of:

1. My 4-H Activities
2. Project Goal Sheet for correct age level
 - Ages 8-11 - Planning for My Project Adventure
 - Ages 12-14 - Illinois 4-H Project Plan
 - Ages 15-18 - Projects Goals and Accomplishments
3. If enrolled in Livestock – Illinois 4-H Livestock Record (Members enrolled in Horse & Pony or Rabbit Project should use Livestock Record for that project instead of Illinois 4-H Livestock Record. These are geared toward those projects.)

Optional: **Kankakee County 4-H Project Award Applications**

4-H'er may fill out Kankakee County 4-H Award Application form – available on line, at the Extension Office or from the Main Club Leader.

1. 4-H'er must be 12 years old by September 1 of current 4-H year. Younger 4-H'ers may apply, and will be given special recognition if score is 75 or higher.
2. Application forms must be turned in with complete set of records at the end of 4-H year. (Dates will be given to Leaders and printed in the 4-H Newsletter.)
3. 4-H'er does not have to be in project area more than 1 year.
4. Candidates may receive a state-provided award medal only once in a specific award category.
5. Continued success in any curriculum area may allow the member to be presented a County Blue Award Certificate. 4-H'er may apply more than one time.
6. County Medal Winners must score 75 points on County Awards Application to win award.
7. 4-H'er may apply in more than one project area.

Award Areas

Achievement (Includes all 4-H project work, leadership & community service during member's 4-H career.)

Animal Science (Beef, Cat, Dairy, Dog, Goat, Horse & Pony, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep, Small Pets, Swine, Veterinary Science, and any related county projects.)

Community Involvement & Global Awareness (Citizenship, Intercultural, Service Learning, and any related county projects.)

Dairy (Dairy Cattle, Dairy Foods, Dairy Goats, and any related county projects.)

Engineering & Technology (Aerospace, Bicycle, Computer Science, Electricity, Geospatial, Robotics, Safety – all areas, Small Engines, Technologies, Tractor, Video/Filmmaking, Welding, Wind Power, Woodworking, and any other related projects.)

Environment & Natural Resources (Camping & Outdoor Living, Entomology, Forestry, Geology, Natural Resources, Shooting Sports, Sportsfishing, Wildlife, and any related county projects.)

Food, Nutrition & Health (All Foods & Nutrition projects and Health - Physical and Mental, and any related county projects.)

Home & Family (Child Development, Consumer Education, Entrepreneurship, Intergenerational, Interior Design, Sewing and Textiles, and any related county projects.)

Personal Development (Communication, Leadership, Photography, Theater Arts, Visual Arts, and any related county projects.)

Plants & Soils (Crops, Floriculture, Horticulture, Plant & Soil Science, and any related county projects.)

Experience Awards

Bronze Clover Award: Complete at least 1 experience in each of the four dimensions.

Silver Clover Award: Complete at least 2 experiences in each of the four dimensions; at least 2 of those experiences must be in the county level or beyond.

Gold Clover Award: Complete 4 experiences in each of the four dimensions; at least 2 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level.

Diamond Clover Award: Complete 6 or more experiences in ONE dimension; at least 4 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level.

Emerald Clover Award: Complete 8 or more experiences in ONE dimension; at least 4 of those experiences must be BEYOND the County level PLUS at least 2 must be at the State or National level.

Club Records

1. Illinois 4-H Standards of Excellence for 4-H Groups (Club Checklist)
2. Secretary's Book
3. Treasurer's Book– **must turn in to re-enroll**
4. Scrapbook

Optional: Illinois 4-H Club/Group Report – To be filled out and submitted if the club has done club project – Community Service, or work in specific project area.

“I Dare You” Award

1. Nomination Form must be turned in to the County Extension office.
2. Nomination should be from an adult who has extensive contact with nominee (4-H leader, project leader, etc.), preferably not a parent.
3. Nominations should be submitted by October 1.
4. Nominees should:
 - a. Be at least a high school junior
 - b. Have been a 4-H member for at least three years (may be in third year of membership).
5. Nominee should exhibit development in leadership, scholarship, and character not only in 4-H but also church, school, and community. Each of these areas should be included in recommendations.
6. Award may be received only once.

“Friend of 4-H Award”

1. Nomination Form must be turned in to the County Extension office.
2. Recommendation should be submitted by October 1.
3. Award is presented to individual or group who has contributed significantly to support of 4-H programs.
4. It is suggested that the award is presented only once to an individual or group.

“4-H Alumni Award”

The Alumni Award provides recognition to 4-H alumni whose contributions to society exemplify effective citizenship, leadership, and public service success in their chosen careers and a sustaining interest in 4-H and similar worthy community endeavors.

1. Nomination Form must be turned in to the County Extension office.
2. Recommendation should be submitted by October 1.
3. Nominee may be any adult who has been previously enrolled in 4-H and who has an outstanding record of accomplishments relating to good citizenship in adult life.
4. Nominee’s record of accomplishments should indicate interest in and support of youth, civic, public, church, or school activities in community and county.

“Kankakee County Key Award”

1. Nomination Form must be turned in to the County Extension office.
2. Recommendation should be submitted by October 1.
3. Nominees should be at least a junior in high school.
4. Proof of nominee’s meeting award requirements should be in written form.
5. Nominee must meet Leadership Standards, listed below for 2 years to receive Key Award.

The Leadership Standards are:

1. Establish plans for member’s project and report on project to leader.
2. Attend at least two-thirds of club meetings (or number determined by club).
3. Share project experiences by giving a talk or demonstration or making an exhibit.
4. Serve on club committee or hold a club office.
5. Take part in a community service activity or in a community activity related to member’s project.
6. Assist leaders with a special club activity, tour or program.
7. Participate in one or more learning experiences at the county, regional, or state level.
8. Provide leadership for a project, activity or 4-H group.
9. Help conduct programs at the local level or beyond.
10. Meet the above items for a minimum of two years, and submit county records for the same two year period.
